## OUR STORY


CEC Indianapolis was established in 1998 primarily doing solid waste engineering. Since then, the office staff and leadership has transitioned. We currently provide services in civil engineering, surveying, landscape architecture, ecological sciences, cultural resources, and environmental engineering. Our surveying group provides drone capabilities, LiDAR services, scanning, and other related services. Our ecological group provides endangered bat surveying services throughout the Midwest, and we're growing our environmental engineering and sciences group. We're also growing our already-strong cultural resources group that provides archaeological investigations, National Register of Historic Places eligibility determinations, archival research, and more throughout the Midwest. We're most active in the markets of real estate (residential, industrial, distribution facilities, and education facilities), oil and gas, power, and public sector, but we also have involvement in mining and manufacturing.

## OUR CULTURE

Our office is in downtown Indianapolis. The vibe in the office is energetic with a lot of activity within walking distance to our office. We frequently walk to lunch with co-workers. Several employees enjoy nearby breweries such as Sun King for after-hours festivities. We have a good mix of young and experienced employees.

## NOTABLE PROJECTS

### *Indianapolis Zoo's Bicentennial Pavilion and Promenade | Indianapolis, IN*

The zoo wanted the Bicentennial Pavilion and Promenade to provide 40,000 square feet of weather-protected space for up to 1,000 seated guests for events. CEC provided surveying and civil engineering services for the project, and worked collaboratively with Ratio Architects. When rainwater contacts the Pavilion's canopy, it is funneled into wooden shade structures and travels down steel rain screens to a plant-filled bed. From there, the water travels through a water quality unit and into a water detention bed. The project won the Construction Award and the Landscape Architecture Award at the 2017 Indianapolis Monumental Awards.

### *Ironworks at Keystone | Indianapolis, IN*

CEC was retained to work with Hendricks Commercial to develop the former Woodfield Centre into Ironworks, a redeveloped \$30M Ironworks at Keystone. This 6.4-acre mixed-use project included 45,000 square feet of retail/restaurant space, 120 hotel rooms, and 120 apartment units. CEC performed survey, environmental, geotechnical engineering, landscape architecture, and civil engineering services.

### *MarkWest Sherwood to Mobley Pipeline Bat Surveys | Wetzels and Doddridge Counties, WV*

Endangered bat species surveys were necessary along 29 miles of MarkWest's proposed Sherwood to Mobley pipeline project to comply with the federal Endangered Species Act requirements. Biologists performed Indiana Bat surveys by means of mist netting 47 survey sites, radiotelemetry, acoustical sampling, potential roost tree/suitable habitat assessments, and cave/mine portal surveys. The team also conducted desktop habitat studies, developed formal study plans, and produced GIS mapping and figures.

### *Cultural Resource Investigations for Allegheny Arsenal Redevelopment | Pittsburgh, PA*

Milhaus wanted to redevelop a portion of land occupied by Allegheny Arsenal, a former munitions manufacturing and military storage facility. The proposed mixed-use development would capture the historic character of the site, which had its first buildings completed in 1820. CEC performed cultural resources investigations consisting of the completion of a project review form, archaeological monitoring during environmental testing, and a Phase IB investigation.
